
Calibrating the Educational Delivery Mode

- Identify any paucity of resources, human / technical / tangible
- Impediments to standardized content delivery
- Alignment of the TOS with the institutional planners
- Alignment of syllabi with university assessments
- Faculty development programs
- Evaluating criteria for internal examiners
- Upkeep of the curricular directives
- Curricular upgrade recommendations

UHS believes in institutional identity based on its diversity and ideology. Respecting all these parameters a uniformity is aimed at and the current program will help calibrate our joint mission for the healthcare academia and healthcare provision.

The program ultimately aims at calibrating the professional competencies of the healthcare professionals trained at UHS for its affiliated institutes and by its affiliated institutes for the community.
