In compliance with the Admission Policy notified by the Specialized Healthcare & Medical Education Department, Government of Punjab, on October 22, 2025, the University of Health Sciences (UHS), Lahore, hereby invites online applications from eligible candidates for admission to the MBBS and BDS programs in the following Public Sector Medical and Dental colleges in Punjab for the 2025-26 academic session:

Eligibility Criteria:

i. MDCAT:

The candidate must have passed MDCAT 2023 or 2024 or 2025 with at least 55% marks for MBBS and 50% for BDS.

Foreign nationals and Overseas Pakistanis may submit MDCAT, or alternatively SAT-II scores (minimum 550 in Biology, Chemistry, and Physics/Mathematics) or MCAT (International)/UCAT scores with at least 50% in above-mentioned subjects.

ii. Qualification:

Applicants must have passed HSSC (Pre-Medical) or an equivalent 12th-grade qualification recognized by IBCC with at least 60% marks, including Biology, Chemistry, and Physics/Mathematics.

For Foreign Self-Finance seats, the candidate must hold a foreign nationality or be an Overseas Pakistani permanently residing abroad, having completed 12th grade or equivalent outside Pakistan, and must provide proof of residence and study from the last attended institution.

Provided that expatriate candidates having Intermediate / HSSC / A-Level with mandatory subjects of Chemistry and Biology are eligible for MBBS / BDS admissions on specified seats and the rest as optional subjects.

iii. Domicile:

A domicile certificate from any district of Punjab is mandatory.

iv. Category of Seats:

- a. Open merit
- b. Reserved seats for:
 - i. Disabled students;
 - ii. Cholistan:
 - iii. Under-Developed District;
 - iv. Reciprocal basis for Punjab candidates in other provinces
 - v. Overseas Pakistanis

v. Quota Seats:

Applicants seeking admission under quota seats must meet the additional eligibility requirements and mandatory documents specified in the Prospectus.

Merit Calculation Formula:

The weightage criteria for calculation of merit for admission shall be as follows:

Matriculation/SSC/Equivalent – 10% F.Sc./HSSC Pre-Medical / Equivalent – 40% MDCAT – 50%

Application Procedure:

- i. Review the Prospectus and the Admission Policy issued by the Government of Punjab for the 2025-26 session available on the UHS website (www.uhs.edu.pk) thoroughly.
- ii. Access the above UHS Online Admission Portal (separate for MBBS and BDS programs).
- iii. Register by providing your Name, Father/Guardian's Name, Email ID, CNIC/Passport/CRC Number, and a Password.
- iv. Upon logging in, select the seat category/categories for which you are eligible.
- v. Complete the application form with personal details, including name, domicile, contact information, address, nationality, gender, date of birth, etc.
- vi. Enter educational qualifications, such as SSC and HSSC marks, year of passing, subjects, etc.
- vii. Provide details of MDCAT score.
- viii. Choose all colleges in order of preference from the dropdown menu; ALL options must be selected according to the seat category.
- ix. Upload scanned copies of required documents, ensuring each file is clear, legible, and does not exceed one MB in size.
- x. Review and acknowledge the Undertaking before submission.
- xi. Generate a fee challan of Rs. 2000/- for the non-refundable application processing fee and deposit it at the Bank of Punjab (BOP)/National Bank of Pakistan (NBP) via branch banking or only 1Bill Invoice (top-up option may not be used). Upload the paid challan receipt on same portal within the stipulated time.
- xii. Download, print, and review the application before final submission. Submit the online application once all information is confirmed to be accurate.
- xiii. Applications may be modified until the deadline for submission. However, the number and order of preferences shall become final and immutable after the deadline.

Mandatory Documents Required:

Applicants are required to upload the following documents as prescribed in Prospectus along with their online application. Failure to submit these documents shall render the application invalid:

i. Matriculation and Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSSC) or their equivalent certificates/result cards attested by the relevant boards.

- ii. Only Punjab domicile certificate of the applicant shall be acceptable (Not mandatory for foreign/overseas quota seat).
- iii. Computerized National Identity Card (CNIC) or B-Form or Passport of the applicant.
- iv. CNIC of the applicant's father, mother, or guardian.
- v. Valid Iqama/Residence Permit/Green Card/Foreign Passport of the applicant in case applying on foreign/overseas quota seat.
- vi. Proof of education (from class 1 to 12) from the same district, duly verified by the relevant Government Authority in case of Under-Developed District quota seat.
- vii. Disability Certificate issued by the relevant Government Authority/Department in case of candidates applying on 'Persons with Disability' seats.

Admission Procedure:

- i. Selected candidates must download their fee challans from the Admission Portal and pay the fee in the designated account at the Bank of Punjab (BOP) / National Bank of Pakistan (NBP) via branch banking or only 1Bill Invoice (top-up option may not be used). Failure to pay within the specified time will result in forfeiture of the admission and opportunity for upgradation.
- ii. Students selected against Overseas Quota seats shall deposit fee in foreign currency i-e US Dollars (\$10,000) per annum in accordance with the PM&DC Notification dated 21-03-2025. Students admitted under the category shall compete the entire programme of study under the same category. An undertaking/bond shall be submitted by the student to this effect.
- iii. Admission is confirmed only upon fulfillment of two conditions: (a) payment of the prescribed college fee and dues by the due date, and (b) joining at the respective college in-writing by the due date as per the procedure prescribed by UHS. Failure to comply with either condition shall render the admission cancelled and that candidate shall have no vested right of admission in that year.
- iv. Any vacant seats created due to non-joining of candidates shall be filled in the subsequent selection lists through upgradation process, based on merit and preferences. The upgradation process is mandatory, and no exceptions will be entertained. Upgraded candidates must report to their new college within the stipulated time. UHS will transfer their fee to the new college accordingly.

- ii. Any candidate found to have submitted forged, fabricated, or false documents/information shall have their application and admission cancelled immediately and disciplinary action may be taken against such candidates as per the provisions of the Prospectus.
