NOTIFICATION

Academic Council, in its 42nd meeting, held on 10th April 2026, on recommendation of the Board of Studies (Medicine) and in exercise of its powers under section 31.(2)(i) of UHS Ordinance 2002, approved to increase the marks allocation for Paediatrics in Final Year MBBS from 200 to 300 marks, with effect from Final Prof. MBBS Annual 2026 Examination. The Academic Council also approved the following division of topics amongst two MCQ-based theory papers, and the revised marks distribution scheme:

Division of Topics:

Paper I: Nutrition, Growth and Development, Neonatology, Gastrointestinal Tract (GIT) diseases, Immunization, Acute Respiratory Tract Infections (ARI) / CDD, Respiratory Diseases, IMNCI, Fluid and Electrolyte Disorders, Paediatric Emergencies.

Paper II: Neurological Disorders, Cardiovascular Diseases, Endocrinology, Nephrology, Haem-oncology, Rheumatology, Child Abuse, Genetics, Infectious Diseases.
