

Abstract Submission Guidelines For Presentation

(Organizers shall select amongst the abstracts for Oral / Poster presentation or Poster display only)

Abstract must not exceed 250 words (excluding title & authors). Use Arial font style 12 point only. Please structure your submission using the subheadings given below. Do not submit in PDF format.

Title: (Upper Case, No Abbreviations)

Investigators:

- Principal Investigator (PI) name to be written first.
- Underline the name of the person who will present the paper if other than PI.
- The names of the investigators must be listed by their First name followed by 2nd (if any) and Family names.
- Omit degrees and titles (Do not write Dr., Professor and others)
- Include affiliations/organization/name of the journal for each investigator. Use superscript numbering *after* the investigator's name to indicate affiliations

Example: XXX¹, YYY¹, ZZZ¹

¹ XYZ (Organization), CITY

Background / Objective: Not more than three sentences.

Methods: For quantitative study include study design, duration of study – time period, sample size, inclusion / exclusion criteria, study protocol including randomization where applicable, variables studied, statistical tests applied, IRB / ERC approval. For qualitative study mention appropriate study design, theoretical paradigm, protocol including interviews, FGDs, structured / unstructured, data transcription, coding and others.

Results: For quantitative studies include numbers and percentages with actual P- values where appropriate. For qualitative studies mention themes with appropriate verbatim where appropriate.

Conclusion: Related to the objectives of the study. No recommendations are needed.
