LIST OF GOLD MEDAL AWARDEES FOR POSTGRADUATE – UHS 4TH CONVOCATION

1. Gold Medals shall be awarded specialty-wise for each MS, MD, Masters, and M.Phil. programs in accordance with the University of Health Sciences Act, Statutes, Regulations, Examination Rules, and other applicable policies governing postgraduate programs.
 2. A Gold Medal shall be awarded only where a minimum of five (05) eligible graduates is available in the respective specialty.
 3. To qualify for the award of a Gold Medal, a candidate must have successfully passed all examinations of the program in the first attempt, without any failure, supplementary examination, repeat attempt, improvement examination, or lapse at any stage of the program.
 4. The Gold Medal shall be awarded to the candidate securing the highest percentage of marks in the Exit Examination of the respective specialty.
 5. In the event of a tie in the Exit Examination percentage, the marks obtained in the Intermediate Module Examination (IME) shall be considered for determining merit. The candidate securing higher marks in the Intermediate Module Examination shall be placed higher in the order of merit.
 6. The candidate must have successfully completed the program within one (01) year after completion of the prescribed duration of training, in accordance with the applicable University Rules and Regulations.
 7. Any graduate aggrieved by his/her eligibility, inclusion, exclusion, or order of merit in this List of Gold Medal Awardees may submit a written representation addressed to the Vice Chancellor, University of Health Sciences, Lahore, together with authentic documentary evidence, not later than 05:00 p.m. on 10th July 2026 either in hard copy or via email at **controller@uhs.edu.pk**. Representations received after the prescribed deadline or without supporting documentary evidence shall not be entertained.
 8. No appeal, review, grievance, claim, or complaint of any nature whatsoever shall be entertained after 05:00 p.m. on 10th July 2026, under any circumstances.
 9. Publication of this list shall not, by itself, confer any vested right upon any candidate to receive a Gold Medal. The conferment of Gold Medals shall remain subject to verification of eligibility, fulfillment of all applicable University requirements, and formal approval by the Competent Authority.
 10. If, at any stage before or after the Convocation, it is discovered that a candidate was declared eligible due to any clerical error, computational error, omission, misrepresentation, concealment of facts, or any other bona fide mistake, the University reserves the right to revise, amend, withdraw, or cancel the award of the Gold Medal, subject to the approval of the Competent Authority.
 11. The decision of the Competent Authority on all matters relating to eligibility, interpretation of rules, determination of merit, and award of Gold Medals shall be final.
