Admissions to MBBS/BDS Program for Students of Balochistan in Private Sector Medical/Dental Institutions of Punjab Session 2023-24

Pakistan Medical and Dental Council (PM&DC), vide its letter dated January 05, 2024, has reserved one seat on full fee basis in each of the private sector medical and dental colleges of Punjab exclusively for the students of Balochistan. The University of Health Sciences (UHS), Lahore, declared as the “Admitting University” by the Government of Punjab, invites applications from eligible students of Balochistan for admission to MBBS/BDS program on these reserved seats in each of the following private sector medical/dental colleges of Punjab for the Session 2023-24:

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. Candidate has Domicile/Local/ Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC) of Balochistan.
2. Candidate has passed his Matriculation and HSSC (Pre-Medical)/equivalent examinations from Balochistan.
3. Candidate has passed HSSC (Pre-Medical) / equivalent examination with minimum **60% marks**.
4. Candidate has qualified the Medical & Dental Colleges Admission Test (MDCAT) - 2023 of any province/region with minimum **55% (i.e. 110/200) marks for MBBS and 50% (i.e. 100/200) marks for admission to BDS program.**

HOW TO APPLY:

- Step 1:** Visit the Online Admission Portal for Private Sector Medical and Dental Colleges on the UHS website (<https://private.uhs.edu.pk/>).
- Step 2:** Create an account by providing your Name, Father/Guardian Name, Email ID and a Password.
- Step 3:** First, indicate your preference for the MBBS and BDS programs. You can choose either MBBS or BDS or both. If you select both MBBS and BDS, you will need to specify your preference for each program.
- Step 4:** Fill in your personal details on the application form, including your name, domicile, contact information, address, nationality, gender, date of birth, etc.
- Step 5:** Enter your qualification details, such as your SSC and HSSC marks, year of passing, subjects/study group, etc.
- Step 6:** Provide details about your MDCAT-2023 scores.
- Step 7:** Determine the order of preference for medical and/or dental colleges. You can select as many colleges as you wish to enter. You can edit your application until the closing date, but the order of preference will be final and unchangeable after the submission deadline. Colleges not included in your preference list will not be considered for admission.
- Step 8:** Upload scanned documents, ensuring each document is within a maximum size of 2 MB, as specified on your application.
- Step 9:** Read and acknowledge the Undertaking/Affidavit. Verify the provided information and attachments before submission.
- Step 10:** Submit the online application. You will receive a confirmation notification via your email address. Download and print both the submitted application and the bank challan for the processing fee.
- Step 11:** Visit the nearest branch of The Bank of Punjab (BOP) with the fee challan to deposit **Rs. 102,000/-** (Rs. 100,000/- refundable token admission fee + Rs. 2,000/- as the non-refundable application processing fee). Your application process is now complete.

IMPORTANT:

1. Applications must be submitted exclusively through the Online Portal of Private Sector Colleges. Any applications that are incomplete or submitted in violation of the prescribed procedure shall be rejected. Failure to pay the prescribed fee by the specified due date shall also result in application rejection. Candidates need to submit separate applications for the MBBS and BDS programs; he/she can select both programs in the same application. While the candidate is not required to submit a print-out of the application or the receipt of paid fee to the University, it is advisable to keep them for your personal records.
2. The candidature/admission of a candidate found to have submitted forged/fake/fabricated documents or incorrect/false information shall be cancelled immediately. The candidates will be required to get their educational documents and certificates verified from the concerned Board of Education and IBCC before his/her provisional admission is confirmed.
3. Merit and Selection Lists shall be made available on the UHS website (www.uhs.edu.pk).
4. **Once the name of the candidate appears in the selection list, he/she will be required to report the concerned college to: (i) mark his/her written joining at the college, and (ii) deposit the prescribed fee of the college by the due date. Only those who complete these actions will be considered as admitted to the program. Once the concerned college confirms the admission, the candidate can claim the refund of Rs. 100,000/- admission token fee paid to the UHS.**
5. **Second selection list will fill vacancies, if any, from the waiting list. It's important to note that there shall be no upgradation of the candidates already admitted in the first selection list.**
6. Since these seats are fully self-financed, candidates are advised to gather information about the annual fee structure of their desired colleges by visiting the respective college websites before selecting any college in his/her order of preference.

7. Incomplete applications and those received after the due date will be rejected. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure timely submission of their application along with all required documents. No notification will be issued if an application is rejected due to any deficiency.
